UNIVERSITY HISTORY



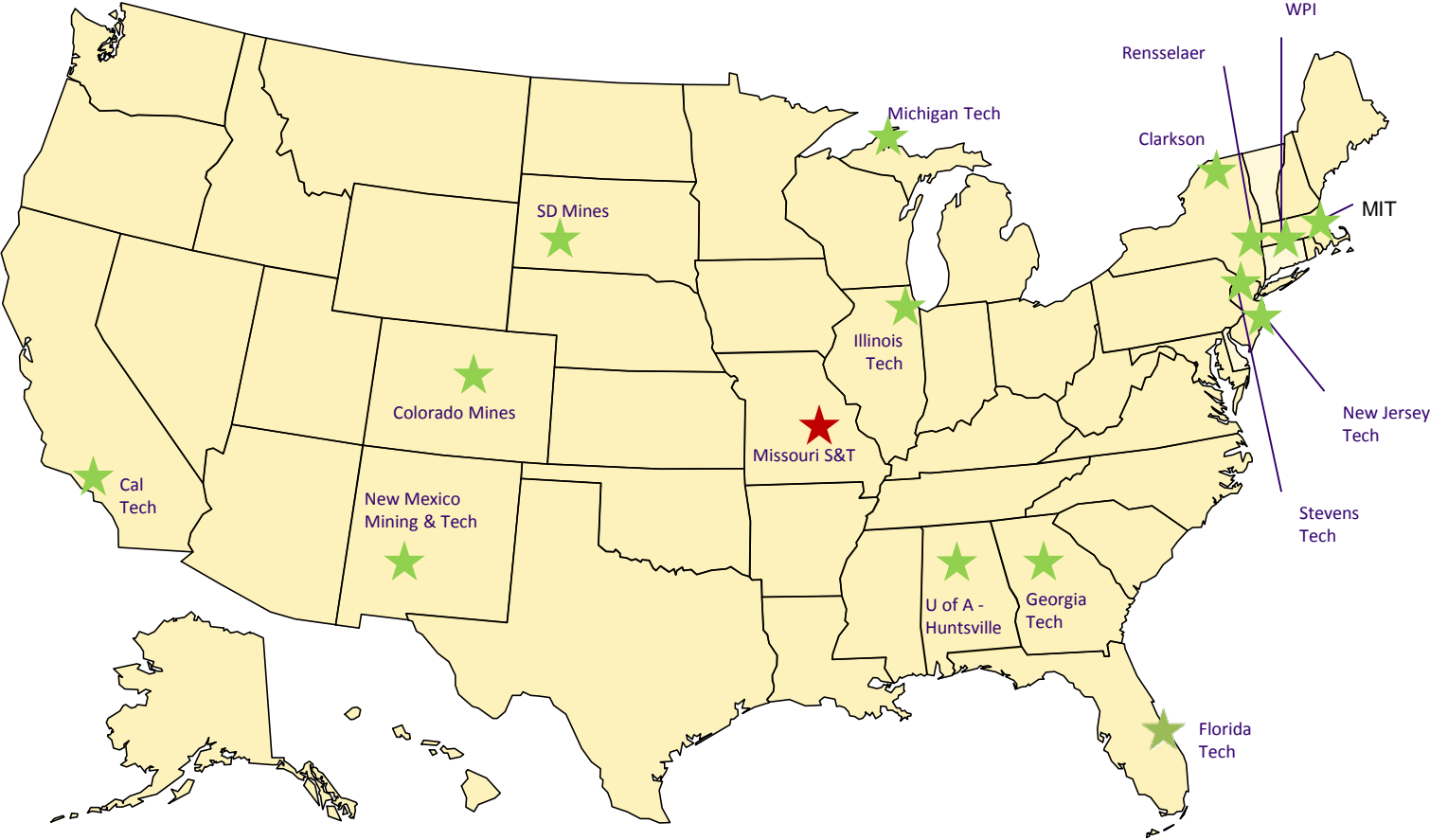
- 1870: Founded as **University of Missouri School of Mines and Metallurgy (MSM)**

- 2008: **Missouri University of Science and Technology (Missouri S&T)** emphasizes STEM focused mission

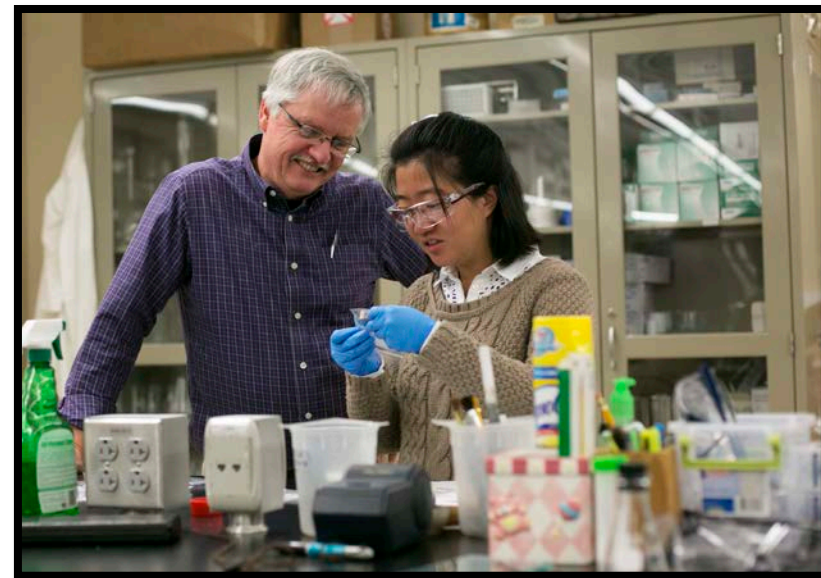

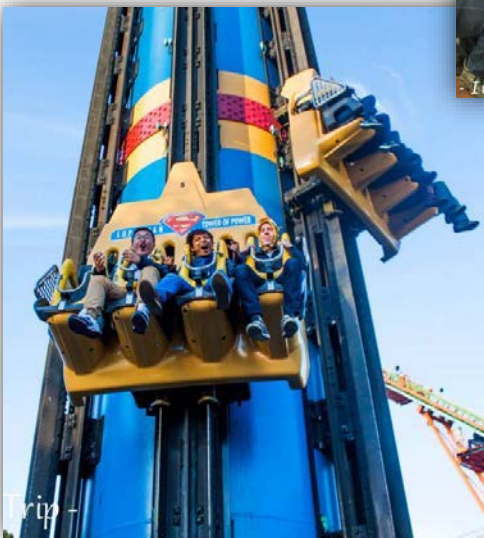

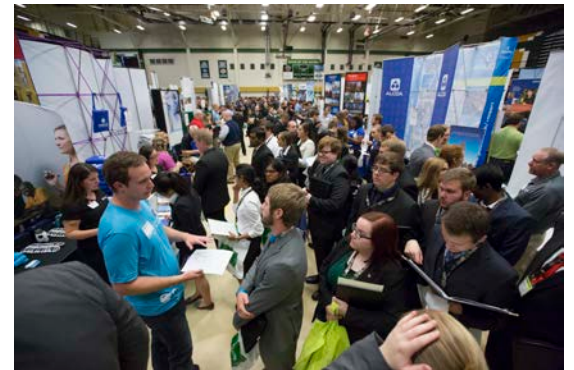


CAREER SUCCESS FOR GRADS

Fall 2016 Career Fair

- > Over 1,158 **companies** recruit on campus:
 - 3,842 on-campus interviews
- > 47 companies hiring **international students**
- > Average starting salary for at commencement:
 - \$61,831 for undergraduates students
 - \$76,632 for graduate students
- > Over 936 **students** completed a co-op or internship for +440 companies around the world
- > Many top corporations, such as Boeing, Monsanto, Caterpillar, Shell Oil, and Toyota list Missouri S&T as a **“top 20 key school”** for finding their future leaders

Undergraduate Transfer Scholarship

- > Amount: **\$4,500**
 - \$2,250 applied to each semester (**total of 4 semesters**)
 - One year award for admissible students from selected partner universities
 - Second-year award renewal with **3.25** S&T GPA
- > Requires **full-time** (12-credit hours) enrollment in academic course work
- > Limited to *undergraduate transfer students* from Missouri S&T partner institution

Transfer Admission Requirements

- > Admission is based on GPA and post-secondary transcript
 - Cumulative GPA of 2.50 or higher on 4.0 scale
- > Complete at least 1 academic year at home institution (24 credit hours)
- > Retake any courses for which a grade of below 60% has been earned
- > **Note:** Courses with scores of less than C or 70% will not be counted for transfer credit

English Proficiency Requirements

- > TOEFL: 79 (550 PB, 213 CB)
 - S&T Test Code: 6876

OR

- > IELTS: 6.0

OR



- > Intensive English Program (IEP) at Missouri S&T

How to Apply as Transfer Student

- > apply.mst.edu
 - Fall Semester Application Deadline: **April 1** (recommended), June 15
 - Spring Semester Application Deadline: **November 15**
- > Apply as **Undergraduate International Transfer Student**
 - Create account and complete application
 - Pay \$50 application fee
- > Request official documents be sent to S&T
- > Check your email regularly

1. Will receive **email notification** from Office of Admissions
2. Submit required **financial documents**
3. Receive I-20, Acceptance Letter, and Admission Material via mail
4. Schedule **Visa Appointment** with U.S. Consulate
5. Apply for dormitory, if desired (reslife.mst.edu)
6. Arrive in Rolla for **New International Student Orientation** before the start of the semester
