




Intensive English Program

- Two 15-week sessions during the academic year (August-December and January-May) and one 9-week session during the summer (June-July)
- Two levels: Intermediate and Advanced
- 18 hours per week in class, courses in grammar, reading, listening/speaking, writing, and academic preparation
- The successful completion is the equivalent of a 79 TOEFL score and can be substituted for the TOEFL requirement

English Language Requirement

• TOEFL:

68 overall on internet based test (Undergrad & Graduate)
 At least 15 in each section is also required in each section (Undergrad)
 (Some areas of study may require a higher TOEFL score)

• or IELTS:

• 6.0 overall with 5.0 in each band (Undergrad & Graduate) (Some areas of study may require a higher IELTS score)

• or PTE:

- 47 overall (Undergrad & Graduate)
 (Some areas of study may require a higher PTE score)
- or the successful completion of PSU's Intensive English Program (IEP)



Admission Procedures

- Step 1: Complete application on-line
- Step 2: Pay the \$60 application fee
- **Step 3:** Submit supporting documents (transcripts/grades, financial support, TOEFL/IELTS/PTE)
- Quick application processing (within 48 hours in most cases)
- Conditional admission offered

- Application deadlines:
 - Fall Semester: June 1
 - Spring Semester: October 15
 - Summer: April 1
